UPLIFT San Diego is a 501c3 nonprofit founded in 1987 with a mission of improving community equity with free services to San Diego's most vulnerable, helping house our homeless neighbors and academically advance low-income students, lifting all to their highest potential.

Our services aim to fill gaps and remove obstacles in the flow to housing for people experiencing homelessness as well as provide quality after school tutoring for underserved youth in our community.

Our Programs



Kids at Heart Tutoring

Kids at Heart provides free, one-on-one tutoring and mentoring for low-income students in grades 1-12 to help them excel academically, graduate high school, and pursue a journey that will help them break free from the cycle of poverty.



Home Team Homeless Services

Home Team mobilizes Volunteer Advocates to work with those experiencing homelessness and their case managers to facilitate housing placement and stability. If chosen for Home Team, you will receive hands-on training and the opportunity to change someone's life for the better.



Swimming Upstream Mentoring

Swimming Upstream is designed to help young women navigate the rough waters of teen life through multi-week, inspirational empowerment & life skills sessions. Since program launch 15 years ago, program participants have achieved 100% High School Graduation rate!



Triple Cross Homeless Services

Triple Cross unlocks housing options for homeless neighbors by providing free fee waivers, application assistance and round-trip transportation to the DMV for CA IDs from Neil Good Day Center, Homeless Response Center, and other homeless service providers.
